



Statutes for the parents' advisory committee (PAC)

Students, teachers, parents and administration of SGC form an educative community.

The purpose of participation is to foster responsibility and cooperation among the members of this community in order to establish identity and improve the overall performance of the school.

1) Members of the PAC are the elected spokespersons of the class committees. The chairperson and four deputies are elected by the PAC with absolute majority for one school year.

The headmaster, his deputy and the spokesperson of the teachers participate in the meeting of the PAC.

- 2) The PAC meets at least once a term or more often if needs demand. It has to be convoked on the request of the trustee, the headmaster or one quarter of the members.
 - 3) The PAC exists as an advisory body. It informs the head about problems affecting pedagogical and other issues and helps solving conflicts in order to facilitate the smooth running of the school.
 - 4) It is expected that participation in a broader range of activities within the school is initiated by the PAC (e.g. library and other duties , social events, school trips etc.) it also includes the economic aspect of the school (fundraising, sponsoring ..).
 - 5) The PAC discusses educational and social matters raised by the staff noting that a stable and nurturing home environment is vital to any success in an academic career. The PAC uses its resources and talents to offer a range of discussion and
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interest groups for a better understanding for parents to deal with educational problems external to the school.
